## Nouns (1): Number

Plural means more than one. Nouns form their plurals in a number of ways:

- (i) by simply adding **s**, e.g. tree – trees, girl – girls
- (ii) nouns that end in **y** before which there is a vowel also form their plural by adding **s**, e.g. donkey – donkeys, toy – toys
- (iii) for nouns that end in **y** before which there is a consonant, the **y** is dropped and replaced by an **i**, we then add **es**, e.g. country – countries
- (iv) for most nouns that end in **f** we change the **f** to **v** and add **es**, e.g. leaf – leaves  
However, some simply add **s**, e.g. chief – chiefs
